Made by the company that builds transportation for your students, the buses that they produce for their custom motor home division are both strong, and luxurious. If you're looking for a wonderful 'Vintage' Bluebird, I am pleased to present this Bus for your consideration.

1987 Bluebird Wanderlodge PT40 8V92 Detroit Diesel 475 HP Engine, and Allison transmission w/ retarder.

12 KW Yanmar Generator. The original owner had previous Bluebird Wanderlodes before he custom ordered this unit based on his many miles behind the wheel of three others. There are over five, single spaced pages of options and changes that were built into this bus. The changes are both large and small and reveal a motor home that reflects the knowledge and wisdom of its original owner. Sadly, health concerns made it impossible for him to use his pride and joy and it was sold to a wonderful couple who used and loved it for the next 17 years. The coach spent summers in Oregon, and winters in the dry climate of the Arizona desert. We are only the third owners of this wonderful coach. There are 127k miles on the bus and it runs as smooth as ever. It is painted Indian silver as a base color, with both Rich Blue Metallic, and Continental Blue as the other two exterior colors. The exterior paint shows fading as it is the original. However, the interior is a work of art. On a scale of one to ten, the interior is a ten! From factory installed blue ceiling lighting for having passenger visibility during night driving, to a sofa cover that is in perfect condition, but wait, it is a cover and the original underneath is brand new! The interior leather is Elmo Blue, the fabric on the sofa is crystal blue. The two swivel chairs are covered in custom upholstery fabric. The interior is done in all light materials. There is no dark Formica used in the coach whatsoever. The interior is bright, cheery, and a wonderful place to enjoy the many, many extra amenities of this wonderful coach. This bus has the twin bed set-up, with a private side-bath including a large shower. There are ample storage cabinets and everything is concealed behind solid closing doors. There is a safe for your valuables, and three roof air conditioners for your comfort. All windows have "Blue Fancy" awnings, and there is ample storage on the lower outside of the bus. There is a gas BBQ, and outside water for your camping pleasure. There are six-way powered leather pilot and co-pilot seats. There are electric drapes, blue carpets, and aluminum front window shades for your privacy in camp. There is a new Dometic refrigerator/freezer as well as instant hot water at the kitchen sink. There is a musical horn that plays 100 songs, there are spot lights, HWH leveling jacks, 1500 watt inverter, bulk oil fill, aux air compressor, power dump valves, security alarm, and two roof mounted storage pods. Coach has been well maintained both at the factory, and at Bluebird dealerships. There is a three-hundred gallon fuel tank, and a 100 gal fresh water tank. We have all the original paperwork, manuals, and build sheets. You will be impressed with this coach. We are sadly having to part with her as we have changed our retirement plans and are settling in the desert as opposed to traveling.

Questions:

**What type of heat? Three types of comfort systems are used in this motorhome: gas/hot air heat; electric heat ; and engine hot water circulating heaters. Three gas/hot air furnaces are used in the coach. Each unit has a separate zone thermostat.**

**One furnace is located in the living room another is the dinette area, and the third in the bedroom. The dinette furnace is also used to supply hot air to the bathroom via a separate duct booster fan controlled by a thermostat in the bathroom.**

**How many gal Gray Water? Black Water?** TANKS: Separate holding tanks for gray water and waste are located in the midsection of the coach. Each holding tank has a separated drain valve, dumping gray water and waste through a common single discharge connection. An individual wet vent system connects both holding tanks to vent stacks located on the coach roof.

The gray tank is located on the left side of the coach and the waste tank is located on the right side of the coach.  
Gray: Approx. 40" 100 GAL; Waste Approx. 100 Gal.  
Fresh water 40 Ft. 116 Gal.

**Tires?** They are 6 years old but only have 7,000 miles on them.
